This is to ensure that children have a great foundation to their learning and can apply this in school. We really appreciate the time taken to support your child at home and can really see the difference it makes to your child's progress.

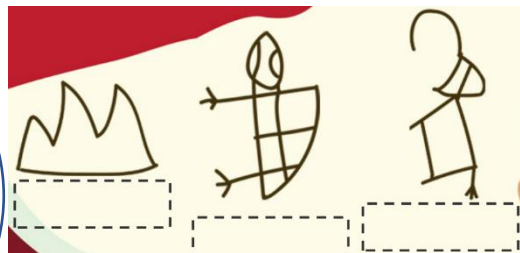

Using your knowledge of the Shang Dynasty, can you create a quiz with 5 questions?

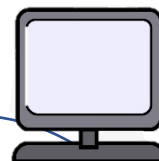

Learning this half term

Maths

We are continuing our work on fractions and decimals this half term, before moving onto money. We are really focusing on practising our times tables.

History

We are learning about the Ancient Shang Dynasty this half term. The children will explore what made the Shang Dynasty one of the most important civilisations in history and know about the importance of the Chou family.

Science

Sound is our focus for science this half term. We will learn how sounds are made and understand that this is through vibrations. We will learn that sound travels through a medium to reach the ear.



English

In our fictional writing, we will be writing a setting description based on our new book 'Planet Omar'. In our non-fiction writing, we will be writing a persuasive letter and in poetry, we will be writing our very own song lyrics!

Art

Our RE focus is about why people pray this half term.

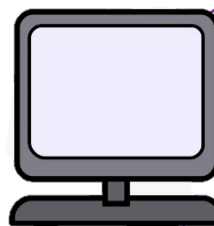


PSHE
