Statutory Spellings – 2/3x per week


TTRS – 5 minutes Daily

<u>Maths</u>

We are continuing our work on fractions and decimals this half term, before moving onto money. We are really focusing on practising our times tables.

<u>Science</u>

<u>History</u>
