

Maths

We will be mainly concentrating on building or skills of multiplication and division this half term, including our quick recall of times tables. We will also be learning about 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Science

Our topic this term is 'Living things and their habitats'. We will be deepening our knowledge of animals as well as learning their classification and adaptations for their habitat.

RE

We will be learning what different people think about God. We will be learning what Christian, Muslim, and Jewish people believe in and why some people believe God exists.

Computing

The children will be exploring how to use spreadsheets. This includes how to navigate a spreadsheet as well as inputting data.

Design Technology

We will be creating Tudor cushions! The children will use their sewing skills and resources to create their own Tudor cushion.

Music

Our focus for music is 'Three little birds' by Bob Marley. The children will learn the song, and use instruments to play along with the song.



English

We are exploring Tudor Times through a fictional book – The boy and the Globe. We will be writing a setting description of Tudor London and biography about Shakespeare, who is one of the main characters in our story!

History

We will be finding out about Henry VIII and what life was like under his rule. We will learn about his life, and also life for rich and poor including homes and food during this period of history. We will also learn about the war of the roses.

PE

We will be having forest school for one session per week. During our other PE session Pupils will be developing their routines and dancing skills! Pupils will develop their ability to change direction with balance and control. They will be given the opportunity to create their own routines/dances in a group and perform them to the rest of the class.
