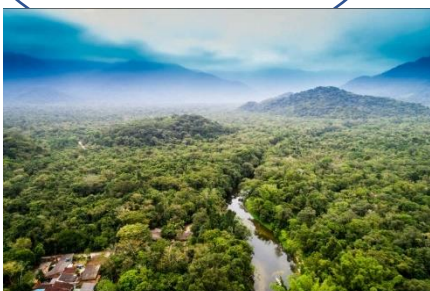

Maths

Geography

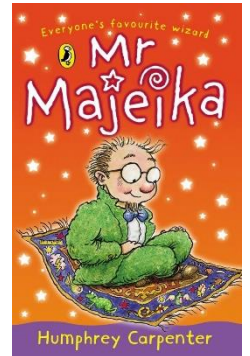
We will describe the four layers of a tropical rainforest and understand how humans are negatively impacting the Amazon rainforest and how we can help to prevent this.

Class 2 Curriculum Overview Spring Term 2

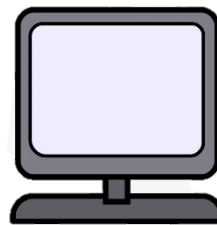


French
